2022 is an exciting year for us. Rato Bangala School turned 30. We couldn't have been more pleased about this. Due to the ongoing pandemic, we limited the main day celebration to the virtual space. But the celebration of our Anniversary will continue throughout the year. On the very day, February 10, all the staff wore a red-themed outfit and took a picture of the formation of 30 made by them in the big green field and had a nice lunch. We then resumed Unit I and Pre-K classes in full-fledged starting March 7. We were happy to have all the students back at school.

The seventh edition of Bal Sahitya Mahotsav (BSM) was held on 25-27 February 2022. BSM is a children's literature festival initiated to encourage and inculcate a reading habit from a very young age. It offered Author readings, Panel discussions, Interactive Workshops, and Presentations for students, educators, and parents. Award-winning authors Vivian Vande Velde, Cartoonist Jenny Campbell, SEL expert Dr. Kathleen Campana, and many other authors, educators, illustrators, and experts attended the festival. The festival also launched RBK's first games for children based on its books: Kasto Biralo Memory Game and Pahilo Puzzle.

Orientation sessions to introduce an environment club under the mentorship of Roots and Shoots (RnS) for grades VI and VII took place on 2 March 2022. Five core members from grade VII with their assistants from grade VI were selected. They will be in charge of creating the club.

The mentors will be mentoring the students to help them create their own set of activities to develop their programs and integrate their club members into the community activities.

Jane Goodall founded RnS to bring together young people to work on environmental conservation and humanitarian issues.

FEDERAL PARLIAMENT OF NEPAL

Simulation of the Federal Parliament took place in grade VIII on 7 March. The students debated on three issues; Millennium Challenge Corporation (MCC)-Nepal Compact, Land Encroachment, and Brain Drain during the mock session of the parliament. This role-playing was a dynamic learning process indeed.

COFFEE HOUSE

This term, students of Grade VIII set up a Coffee House in class to share the poems they had written during the poetry writing sessions. It was genuinely an emotional gathering of young poets. The various poems written in different poetic forms were of a top-notch standard.

Interested students from grades VII to IX registered for the web page designing competition. We organized the competition in the computer lab from 9-11 March 2022. The participants were allowed to bring the text, pictures, and CSS codes

WORLD POETRY DAY

We celebrated World Poetry Day on 21 March 2022 in RBS with the students of grade VI reciting poems in Chhanda. The jamming session took place in the library led by Ms. Amita and Ms. Sudha. The students revisited poems they learned in the junior grades and were excited to share spontaneously.

GUEST TALKS

Grade IV had a Dental talk program by Dr. Neil Pande on 23 December 2021. He made the children aware of the importance of dental health. He focused on healthy food habits and a balanced diet to keep our teeth healthy. We conducted a talk program on the Bagmati River and Water pollution by Dr. Nirina Khadgi and Dr. Sasmita Poudel of NAYAN (National Young Academy), Nepal, for grade IV on 8 February 2022 as they are studying *The River System*. They focused on the present condition of the river Bagmati. She discussed the causes of pollution, water-borne diseases, causes and how we can prevent further damage. We celebrated Global Banking week by organizing an interactive session led by Bankers from Nepal Investment Bank. On 21 March 2022, students of grades II and III learned how a bank functions. The students had many queries about how a bank works and contributed their knowledge about it.

Students of grade III visited Nepal Investment Bank at Durbarmarg on 23 March to witness how people have banking transactions carried inside a bank, from a teller to an ATM.

FRUIT AND VEGETABLE MARKET

Grade III completed its Market Study by setting up its much-awaited fruits and vegetable market on 28 March. Market Study allows them to learn about how food comes to the table. It teaches them about the wholesale and retail process. They gained multiple skills such as problem-solving, money transactions, estimation, calculation and the importance of interdependence, and what it takes to grow and provide food.

MINI SPORTS MEET

Unit I students had a Mini Sports Meet day on 31 March 2022. They had track and field events and a few fun games. Children practiced their balancing skills and improved their motor skills while playing the games. This event became special for them as teachers also had a race to showcase.

THE DUKE OF EDINBURGH'S AWARD

Bronze, Silver, and Gold Journeys On 10-13 December 2021, Silver and Gold Award participants of A2 completed their practice journey in Champadevi, Manichaur, Shivapuri, and the Lakuri Bhanjyang area. There were 9 Gold and 13 Silver participants in this journey.

Similarly, on 18 and 19 December 2021, 19 Bronze participants who couldn't join the previous practice journeys from A2 completed their remaining requirements of the Award. They completed their practice journey in Namobuddha and Lakuri Bhanjyang area.

At the beginning of 2022, two Silver participants and 18 Bronze participants completed their Award. A-Level Duke of Edinburgh's International Gold and Silver Award participants completed their Qualifying Adventurous Journey to Langtang valley and Kyanjin Gompa as their last destination. The expedition started on 22 March and ended on 27 March 2022. 230 participants are pursuing different levels of Award this year as well.

RBS DEBATES

The fourth iteration of RBS Debates took place on 11-13 February 2022. We had invited Adjudicators from Nepal and outside. A total of 135 members participated in the tournament as debaters, adjudicators, judges, Chief Adjudication Panel (CAP), observers, and members of the organizing committee. Two teams received full need-based scholarships. International participation was more this year.

The tournament had five preliminary rounds. The team winning the novice category was AMIGOS. Similarly, the best speaker for the Open Grand finals was Arik Karim from Team Orion, and for Novice Finals was Sneha Maskey from Team AMIGOS.

The sponsors for the tournament were Asmita Publications, PACAsia, and Dalle; Debate Network Nepal was the advisor. Digital Matter Files supported in organizing two workshops. It was a huge success given the amount of exposure RBS Debates provide to Nepali teams from and outside RBS. Congratulations to the organizers of the RBS Debates.

ECONOMICS OLYMPIAD

We would like to congratulate Aryan Shrestha for securing the Bronze Medal in the 4th International Economics Olympiad 2021 and Aadit Subedi for making his way to the National Competition of Nepal Economics Olympiad 2022.

This assessment will help Nepali teachers understand and use the Early Grade Reading materials in their classroom in an organized manner. It will further assist in determining each child's reading level and making an individualized plan to grow their reading through tailored teaching.

EVENT ON WOMEN'S LEADERSHIP IN EDUCATION

ICT Assistance

On 7 March 2022, a program was organized by RBPOP to distribute projectors and laptops each to 10 community schools as requested by the Lalitpur Municipality. The Mayor of Lalitpur municipality, Mr. Chiribabu Maharjan, was the chief guest for the program.

We are glad to be a part of the initiation made by LMC to develop all community schools into community-friendly schools. RBPOP coordinator visited 9 out of 10 schools to ensure the planning of schools to make them technologyfriendly. An interactive session with principals and LMC officers was held on March 3, 2022, to enable the effectiveness of these materials.

School Improvement in Gorkha and Terhathum

The partnership with Bhimsen Thapa Gao Palika moved forward after signing the MOU between Bhimsen Thapa Gaon Palika and RBPOP on 16 December 2021. The Ward Chief, Mr. Ishwor Pandey, and Director of Rato Bangala School, Dr. Shanta Dixit, signed the MOU. Ms. Milan Dixit, Principal of Rato Bangala School, was present at the ceremony. Two field officers from Gorkha and Aathrai Terhathum will be joining the training in Kathmandu from 27 March till 1 April 2022. They will be working in the partner schools to help teachers and the principals implement the learnings and work closely to report to RBPOP.

Menstrual Health Awareness

In collaboration with Putali Foundation, RBPOP will run a menstruation health awareness program. It will support 90 students from 3 schools and their mothers through training, menstruation hygiene kits, and a menstrupedia comic, a friendly guide to healthy periods.

Material Distribution In Surkhet

As requested by one of the schools in Surkhet, Shree Bhanu Basic School, RBPOP sent stationeries, books, and playing materials to the school on 3 Jan 2022. The school runs from EC class to grade 5, where most of the students are from marginalized communities.

Early Childhood Development Training

In collaboration with Rato Bangala Foundation, we had organized early childhood development training for 32 teachers of Cohort II from 4-13 March 2022. It focused on implementing 11 essentials in the classrooms developed by RBF.

Pingal Children's Library

RBPOP reopened the Pingal Children's Library, a community library inside the premises of Rato Bangala School, where anyone in the community can visit and enjoy books and have fun learning.
